General Rules and Regulations

1. General Rules

1. The course is conducted by Children's Research University, Gandhinagar.
2. The duration of the course shall be 60 Hours spread over approximately 6 months.
3. The medium of instruction shall be Gujarati.
4. The course shall consist of theory, practical sessions, demonstrations, group discussions, workshops, and field activities.
5. The University reserves the right to modify the course schedule, faculty, or curriculum whenever necessary.

2. Eligibility

1. The applicant must have passed Higher Secondary (12th Standard) from any recognized board.
2. Parents, expecting parents, grandparents, caregivers, Anganwadi workers, preschool teachers, and individuals interested in early childhood development are encouraged to apply.
3. Admission shall be granted on a First Come, First Served basis subject to seat availability.

3. Admission Procedure

1. Admission shall be confirmed only after submission of:
 - Completed application form by google form
 - Copy of educational qualification
 - Payment of prescribed course fee
2. Incomplete applications may be rejected.
3. Admission once confirmed is non-transferable.

4. Course Fee

1. Course Fee: ₹2,000/-
2. Fees once paid shall not be refunded.
3. Examination and certificate charges, if applicable, shall be as notified by the University.

5. Attendance

1. A minimum of 70% attendance is compulsory to appear in the final evaluation.
2. Participants with attendance below 70% may not be eligible for certification.
3. Attendance shall be maintained separately for theory and practical sessions.
4. Leave due to genuine medical reasons shall be considered only on submission of valid supporting documents.

6. Evaluation Pattern

The evaluation shall consist of:

- Internal Assessment
- Practical Activities

- Assignments
- MCQ Examination
- Descriptive Examination
- Participation in Workshops and Demonstrations

7. Passing Criteria

1. A participant must secure at least 40% marks in the overall assessment.
2. Minimum attendance requirement must also be fulfilled.

8. Certification

A Certificate in Parental Education (Up to Three Years Old Children) shall be awarded to participants who:

- Successfully complete the course.
- Fulfil attendance requirements.
- Pass the prescribed evaluation.
- Clear all financial dues.

9. Cancellation of Admission

The University reserves the right to cancel admission if:

- False information is submitted.
- Fees remain unpaid.
- Serious misconduct occurs.
- University rules are violated.

10. Grievance Redressal

Any grievance regarding admission, attendance, evaluation, or certification shall be submitted in writing to the Course Coordinator/University Academic Committee, whose decision shall be final.

16. Amendments

The University reserves the right to amend these Rules and Regulations whenever necessary. Any such amendments shall become effective immediately upon notification.
